Town Clerk Werth reported that she took in \$938.36 and remitted \$890.36 to the Supervisor for local share, \$48.00 to NYS Ag. & Markets for spay/neuter program.

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• Met with Levi Wolcott regarding mapping the new section at Maple Lawn Cemetery. He will email Supervisor Hynes a quote along with a list of the other services they provide.

Councilpersons

Councilman Coughlin discussed Mr. Hoover's email regarding the Solar Committee. After discussion it was decided Supervisor Hynes would call Brad Mudrzynski, Planning Board Chair and ask that he oversee this committee. She will also reach out to Mr. Hoover to let him know what the Board decided.

The Town Board would like to send a letter to Hecate to confirm their concerns of traffic safety at the intersection of State Route 98 and Lockport Road.

Councilman Chamberlain shared his concerns regarding Hecate selling to Greenbacher.

Councilwoman Marshall shared that Fire Departments in other states are sending bills for accidents and others calls they respond to. Supervisor Hynes will ask Mr. Yager at Emergency Management about this.

Councilwoman Marshall discussed the meeting she went to regarding Genesee County's Flood Insurance Rate Map with FEMA and DEC. Elba will add 10 new parcels and 21 will be taken out. Towns will have until October 10th to write in with any comments. Councilwoman Marshall will share the list for Elba once it is received from the Planning Department. Town Clerk Werth will add the Town map to the website once she receives it. A final meeting will take place in February 2025 after taking in all the Town's suggestions.

Councilwoman Marshall shared that GAR Associates is the company who reassessment evaluations. Would like to further investigate this after solar is in place.

The Town Board would like to include \$500 in the next budget for a concert next summer, and will ask the Betterment Committee to help see it through.
