Discussion took place regarding the Solar Committee. Mr. Hoover will stay on the Committee as a member and Mr. Mudrzynski will now be the Chairman.

Councilwoman Marshall asked if Supervisor Hynes followed up with Tim Yaeger, Genesee County Fire Coordinator regarding fire departments charging for accidents. He did not believe that Albany would not allow the volunteers to charge in New York State. The paid departments may be able to. Supervisor Hynes will continue to discuss this with Mr. Yaeger and Councilwoman Marshall will look back to which out of state fire department she received bill from in the past.
